Melody's Stole

Denise Twym



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One skein of Sandrasingh.com Lace and a photo of Melody the running sheep, was all the inspiration needed to create this beautiful, versatile and unique lace scarf: Melody's Stole.

Info:

Size:

21" x 61"

Yarn:

Sandrasingh.com Lace (100% merino; 950 yd [869 m]/100 g [3.53 oz]): Electric Blue, 0.5 skeins

Gauge:

14 sts and 16 rows = 4"
in Right or Left Diagonal
Openwork Pattern
32 rows = 4 inches in garter
stitch.

Tools:

US #8 (5 mm): 32" circular
(cir) needle or straight
needles
2 Markers (m) & Yarn needle

Notes:

- The edging is worked at the same time as the main body of the shawl.
- You will be knitting from two sets of instructions at the same time.
- Slip the last stitch of every row to get a smooth selvedge.

Stitches

Right Diagonal Openwork Pattern (Multiple of 4+2 sts)

- Row 1 (RS):** (Yo, k3tog tbl, yo, k1) to last 2 sts, yo, k2tog tbl.
Row 2 and every following WS row: Purl.
Row 3: K2tog tbl, yo, (k1, yo, k3tog tbl, yo) to end.
Row 4: Purl.
Row 5: K2, (yo, k3tog tbl, yo, k1) to end.
Row 6: Purl.
Row 7: K1, (yo, k3tog tbl, yo, k1) to last st, k.1
Row 8: Purl.

Left Diagonal Openwork Pattern (Multiple of 4+2 sts)

- Row 1 (RS):** K1, (yo, sk2p, yo, k1) to last st, k1.
Row 2 and every following WS row: Purl.
Row 3: K2, (yo, sk2p, yo, k1) to end.
Row 4: Purl.
Row 5: K2tog, yo, (k1, yo, sk2p, yo) to last 4 sts, k1, yo, ssk, k1.
Row 6: Purl.
Row 7: K1, k2tog, (yo, k1, yo, sk2p) to last 3 sts, yo, k1, yo, ssk.
Row 8: Purl.

Edging (14 sts)

- Row 1 (RS):** K2, yo, k2tog, k5, yo, k2tog, yo, k3.
Row 2 and every following WS row: K1, yo, k2tog, knit to marker.
Row 3: K2, yo, k2tog, k4, (yo, k2tog) 2x, yo, k3.
Row 5: K2, yo, k2tog, k3, (yo, k2tog) 3x, yo, k3.
Row 7: K2, yo, k2tog, k2, (yo, k2tog) 4x, yo, k3.
Row 9: K2, yo, k2tog, k1, (yo, k2tog) 5x, yo, k3.
Row 11: K2, yo, k2tog, k1, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 5x, k2.
Row 13: K2, yo, k2tog, k2, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 4x, k2.
Row 15: K2, yo, k2tog, k3, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 3x, k2.
Row 17: K2, yo, k2tog, k4, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 2x, k2.
Row 19: K2, yo, k2tog, k5, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k2.
Row 20: K1, yo, k2tog, k11.





Chart A: Right Diagonal Openwork



Stole

Loosely cast on 64 stitches.

Set up

Row 1 (RS): K4, pm, k46, pm, work Row 1 of Edging.

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8 & 10: Work Edging, sm, knit across to second marker, sm, k4.

Rows 3, 5, 7 & 9: K4, sm, knit across to second marker, sm, work Edging.

Body

Cont working the Edging as set; **AT THE SAME TIME** begin Right and Left Diagonal Openwork patterns as follows:

****Row 1 (RS):** K4, sm, work Row 1 of the Right Diagonal Openwork pattern to marker, sm, work Edging.
Cont in set pattern until a total of 2 8-row repeats of Right Diagonal Openwork pattern have been worked.

Repeat Rows 3-10 of Set up.

Next Row (RS): K4, sm, work Row 1 of the Left Diagonal Openwork pattern to marker, sm, work Edging.
Cont in set pattern until a total of 2 8-row repeats of Left Diagonal Openwork pattern have been worked.

Repeat Rows 3-10 of Set up.

Repeat from ** five times more.

Ending

Repeat Rows 3-10 of Set up, then repeat Rows 3-4 once more. Bind off loosely.

Finishing

Soak shawl and block to dimensions. Weave in ends.
